History & Background

The Federal Way Pool is run by the City of Federal Way. It was built as part of the Federal Way Community Center and consists of 2 pools: a six lane lap pool; and a leisure type pool with a lazy river, water spray features, beach entry, a two story water slide and spa.

This facility offers a variety of community programming including swim lessons, water exercise, lap and open swims. Rentals are provided for both high school and private swim teams. The pool is also home to Special Olympics swim team, “**The Flounders**.” Pool users are able to use the other amenities (weight room, track, etc.) offered in the center.



Pool Statistics

The pool is located at 876 S. 333rd St, Federal Way, WA 98003. The lap pool has six lanes, 25 yards in length, maintaining a temperature of 84°F. The leisure pool maintains a temperature of 86°F.
